VOTER REGISTRATION

To be eligible to vote, you must

- 1) be 18 years of age by the next election
- 2) be a U.S. Citizen
- 3) be a resident of Kansas

If your name changes or you move, you must re-register prior to the next election. The deadline to register or re-register to vote in any election is 14 days prior to that election. To vote in the August Primary, you must be registered by July 21, 2008. To vote in the November General Election, you must be registered by October 20, 2008.

State law requires that all first-time voters show identification at some point during the registration process.

FUN ELECTION FACTS

- As of January 10, 2008, there were 41,005 registered voters in Leavenworth County.
- There are 32 different polling places including schools, churches, fire stations, and other public buildings.
- 16- and 17-year-old students can serve as election workers
- Federal, State and County offices are elected in the fall of even numbered years. City and School offices are elected in the spring of odd numbered years.

ELECTRONIC VOTING

- In August 2006, Leavenworth County voters first used the iVotronic® touch-screen voting machine.
- This machine allows the voter to review ballot choices, and will check for common errors such as undervotes and overvotes so that they can be corrected before casting the ballot.

VOTING

LOCATIONS and HOURS

After registering, you will receive a voter registration certificate which shows the location of your voting place. On Election Day, you must vote at your polling place. If you are unsure where to vote, contact the Election office for further assistance.

Polling places open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m. All voters who are in line at 7:00 p.m. are allowed to vote.

ADVANCE VOTING INFORMATION

Advance voting begins in the election office 20 days prior to each election and ends at noon the day before the election.

You may also request an advance ballot by mail. To request a ballot by mail, you must submit an Advance Ballot Application no later than 4 days prior to the election. If you receive an advance ballot, it must be returned to the election office, not a polling place, by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day to be considered.
